#### GUIDELINES

##### ART & PHOTOGRAPHY CONTEST

*Dr. Mukwege finds inspiration from the strength of women. Who or what inspires you to keep going when defeat would be an easier response? Create a piece of artwork that depicts where you get your strength from and what keeps you going when the challenges seem too great.*

**WHAT:** Presented by The Echo Foundation, the “Justice Is Not Negotiable” project offers contests in two categories: **ART & PHOTOGRAPHY**. Students are invited to respond to the above challenge in either medium. The Art submission must be 2-D and can include paint, collage, mixed media, textiles, etc.

**WHO:** The contest is open to all Charlotte area high school students, grades 9 – 12.

**WHEN:** Entry forms and submissions must be postmarked or received by The Echo Foundation at 1125 East Morehead Street, Suite 101, Charlotte, NC 28204, by **Friday, February 7, 2020**.

**HOW:** Entry forms may be downloaded at [www.echofoundation.org](http://www.echofoundation.org) or obtained at The Echo Foundation office. No student name should appear on the front of a submission and an entry form must accompany each entry.

**PURCHASE AWARDS AND CATEGORIES:** First (\$100), second (\$75) and third (\$50) prizes will be given in each of the two categories: Art and Photography. All other Art and Photography entries can be reclaimed following the contest’s judging until March 15, 2020.

**JUDGING AND RULES:** Educators and professionals in the corresponding fields will serve on the judging panel. The panels reserve the right to not award a cash prize in a category if the submissions do not meet the qualifications for entry. 2-D original artwork or photography may not exceed 36” in height or width, be easily portable and able to hang on the wall.
